Trust Land Goals 2022-2023:

Goal #1 - Language Arts:

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year, the percentage of students in grades k-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in reading will increase by 1%.

2020-2021- 64% of 1st grade students were proficient and/ or made typical progress or better on the Acadience Reading assessment.

2021-2022- 77% of 1st grade students were proficient and/or made typical progress or better on the Acadience Reading assessment.

Park Elementary had a 13% increase in proficiency and/or typical progress or better on the Acadience Reading assessment. Did not show improvement or decline from the previous year.

Goal #2 - Math:

By the end of 2021-2022 school year, the percentage of students in grades 3-5 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will increase by 1%.

2020-2021- 36% of students in grades 3-5 were proficient in math on the RISE state assessment.

2021-2022 - 52% of students in grades 3-5 were proficient in math on the RISE state assessment.

Park had a significant increase of 16% in the percent of students who were proficient.

This plan will be publicized in the school newsletter as well as on the school website.

Digital Citizenship (Sheree Storrer):

Web filtering:

-Nebo provides a content filtering system.

- It works pretty good, however,we are still advised to thoroughly watch anything we show our students
- YouTube - latest feature in the district - under each video is (watchable/ not watchable by Nebo.edu) there is the option to make it watchable if needed (history videos, etc.)
- Some classes have it so that students are not allowed on YouTube and those teachers embed the video as much as possible

Class website:

- Is used as a resource for each grade and digital citizenship
- Class page takes them directly to the activity that they need for that exact week.
- Digital citizenship page - common sense media. There are lessons and pages prepared that go over our digital footprints, internet safety read alouds etc.
- MLL- (multilingual learners) - can use duolingo to help participate and to feel welcome.
- ABCYa is a Nebo certified website that students can use in computers.
- Classes need 6 stickers to earn a 'free day' on computers, they can go to the district approved website page to choose which they would like to do on that day.

Leader in Me Day/ Celebration
